Dear Praying Friends,

Happy New Year! Perhaps this will be the year that the Lord returns! (Revelation 22:20)

Another year is dawning, and we are excited to see what the Lord will bring to you and to us in 2006. Since we last wrote, we have had the opportunity to present our ministry to eight churches, to face the trial of a car accident, to enjoy some time with family over the holidays, to be in a wedding, and to see the Lord provide another individual supporter. We are now at 27% support.

As we start this New Year, we want to say "A BIG THANK YOU" to each prayer and financial supporter. We have greatly enjoyed being with God's people in various ministries across the Midwest. Your ministry to us has been invaluable. Our dependence upon God has increased, and we are finding that He is using you to supply our needs.

We found ourselves deeply depending upon God this past December 12. Around 12:30 in the afternoon, we were returning from a meeting when we had a severe car accident in Duluth. One missionary was once overheard saying, "I had time to pray for my family; if I had only had a few more seconds to pray for the car!" Thanks to your prayers and the protecting arms of our strong Lord, we were kept from any serious injuries. However, our vehicle was totaled. The past few weeks have been spent recouping, dealing with insurance, and finding a replacement vehicle.

We praise the Lord for a Christian car dealer who was able to purchase a '98 Chevy Lumina for us at wholesale prices. Please pray for this dealer's business. Prairie du Pine Motors of Brainerd, Minnesota, will have to close its doors if sales do not pick up within the next few months. This would close a valuable ministry of vehicle replacement for pastors and missionaries.

In addition to the accident, we have found ourselves becoming more reliant upon God to meet our daily needs. As of January 1, I (Paul) am no longer working full time at my secular job. I am working on an "as-needed" basis. Usually this means no more than eight to sixteen hours a week. Please pray that the Lord will keep our unexpected bills small and that we will continue to faithfully depend upon Him during this new stage of pre-field ministry.

This change brings a welcome relief from this added responsibility. I now have more time available to dedicate to ministry, for which I am grateful. Our family is able to travel for longer periods of time and to better prepare for the weekly meetings. Please pray that the Lord will give us wisdom as we book meetings for the upcoming spring and fall.
