Dear Praying Friends,

On October 1, 2004, our little girl, Felicia Noel, was born. After her birth, we seriously engaged in pre-field ministry. Yesterday we celebrated her second birthday. We pray the Lord will save her early in life. She is showing interest in prayer. Our hearts rejoice when she says things like "Thank you Jesus . . . sunshine!" Will you please pray that we will be faithful in training her in the ways of the Lord?

**1, 2, 3 . . .**

We are teaching Felicia how to count. Mommy is working on Spanish and English, while I am working on Dutch and English. Actually our whole family is working with numbers. Since July we have gone from 46% to 53%! This is a direct answer to your prayers. In our previous edition we asked you to pray that we would reach 50% support by the end of summer. The Lord has answered. Please adjust your prayer goal for our family. We are asking the Lord to allow us to reach 65% by the end of fall. This will help us stay on track to reach Uruguay by the end of 2007.

**A, B, C . . .**

In the coming year we will begin teaching Felicia her letters. Learning the alphabet is fundamental to ones' education. We have feel like this time of pre-field ministry is the Lord's way of reminding us of the fundamentals. A fundamental of missionary work is sharing the Gospel. We were especially pleased with an invitation to help in a vacation Bible time at Redwood Falls, Minnesota, in July. As a result we were able to share the Gospel every day with children and some teenagers too. God gave us the special blessing of being able to visit with a Hispanic family in town as well. The Lord blessed the week with a boy's salvation and multiple new contacts for the church. What a privilege to witness God's abundant grace and mercy at work in the lives of those we meet!

**Red, Yellow, Green . . .**

These colors form a little game that we play in the car as we travel through towns and cities. In the past three months, we have visited 13 churches. We praise the Lord for the safety He granted in traveling over 4,700 miles. On one occasion another car came into our lane, placing us on the shoulder for a few moments. We are so thankful for the Lord's protection! Our recent travels resulted in two more churches pledging support. They also led us to several churches that know "Mom" Kuhns. She enjoyed seeing many of her supporters on our ministry website as we visited their churches. Please continue to pray for safety as we travel in these coming winter months.

Red means stop; green means go, and yellow means slow down. We are slowly getting our household belongings together to ship to Uruguay. The Borrmanns, another BWM family headed to Uruguay, are planning to send a container to Uruguay this November. They are graciously allowing us to ship most of our household belongings in their container. Both of our families are in somewhat of a holding pattern because they are currently at 95%. They need 100% support before they can leave for Uruguay. This directly affects when they will ship their container and when we will pack up most of our household goods. Please pray that they will quickly reach 100% support, for us as we adjust to a simpler lifestyle, and for wisdom for both families as we make decisions on what items to ship.

**Circle, Square, Triangle . . .**

These come in all sizes and shapes. Please pray that the Lord will continue to open doors of opportunity to serve. We currently have two Sundays available in November as well as the month of December. We are grateful that our schedule is starting to fill up for next spring. Our desire, as we visit churches, is to be used of God to further His work. We also desire to find churches that will identify with us in ministry.
